

St. Theresa School Tuition Policy 2017-2018

The following are the tuition rates and fees for the 2017-2018 School Year.

1. **(NEW)** Tuition is paid in full or on a monthly payment plan over a twelve-month period, beginning July 2017 through FACTS Management Company. If tuition is paid in full by June 1, 2017 there will be a 2.5% discount.

For families re-enrolling, the non-refundable re-enrollment deposit will be charged to your FACTS account on **March 1, 2017**.

(NEW) For students who have been accepted and enrolled, but decide to withdraw before **August 15, 2017**, a 50% deduction will be applied to tuition refunds. (If a family has paid the full tuition at this time, then the 50% deduction will apply only for two months, and the remainder will be fully refunded.)

(NEW) For students who have been accepted and enrolled, but decide to withdraw **after August 15, 2017**, only the tuition paid during the month of September or later will be refunded on a prorated basis according to the number of weeks attending during that month of withdrawal. Tuition received for July and August and the completed months of attendance will be forfeited.

2. In the event of a financial crisis, such as unemployment or serious health concern, which prevents making regular tuition payments, a family must contact the Pastor/Principal promptly.
3. **A family seeking tuition assistance for the coming school year must complete a Tuition Assistance Application available online at <https://factsmgt.com/parent-resources/grant-and-aid/>. This application is due to FACTS Tuition Aid by March 17, 2017.** This information,

plus a review of the family's service to the parish and the funding available, will be used to make a fair decision concerning tuition reduction.

4. Parishioner Tuition is offered to a family when they live within the parish boundaries, are registered members of St. Theresa Catholic Church, and are participating members of the parish community.
5. **Since the religious education and spiritual formation of a child are the primary goals of St. Theresa Catholic School, families who do not regularly attend Mass will not be eligible for Parishioner tuition rates.**
6. Please note that the whole parish supports the operations of the school; tuition revenue does not cover all of these costs. Therefore, everyone must make the sacrifice of time, talent, and treasure to support the mission of the parish, not only the school.
7. If a family has outstanding fees (i.e. tuition, service hours payment, lost textbooks, etc.) the official transcripts will not be sent to the new school until the account is paid in full.
